What You Need To Know

How to prepare for your test:

No special preparations. If you have had mammograms or breast ultrasounds done at another facility, however, we will need to have these films.

How long will the test take?

About 30 minutes for each breast.

What is the purpose of the test?

This test, used in conjunction with a physical exam and/or a mammogram, can identify cysts, tumors, abscesses, lymph nodes, and very dense breast tissue.

How is the test performed?

You will be asked to remove your top and bra. You will be given a paper or cloth gown to cover yourself. You will be instructed to lie or sit on an examining table. Gel will be placed on your skin and a transducer (a handheld device that directs the high-frequency sound waves to the breast tissue) will be moved over the area being examined. The examiner may feel the area for any lumps while performing the examination. The images obtained will be seen on a monitor or stored on film.

Required before test:

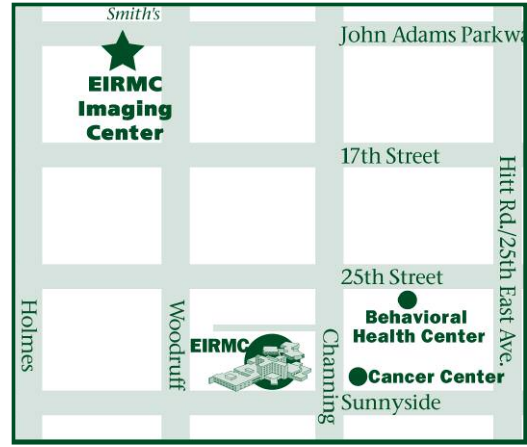
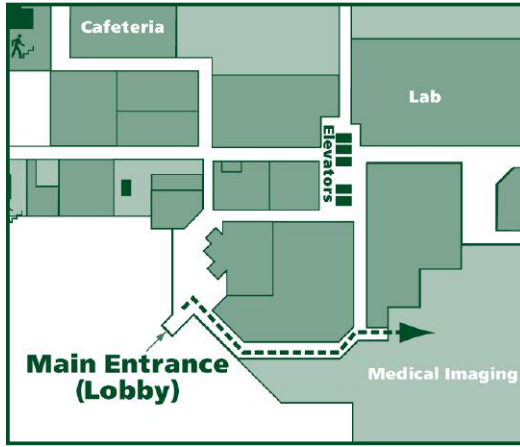
Please provide a signed physician order to perform the exam.
